



## 2018 INTERCHANGE AGREEMENT

SEWF DIV 1/DIV 2, SE DEVELOPMENT  
AND FRANKSTON DISTRICT JUNIOR FOOTBALL LEAGUE


The purpose of this interchange agreement is to allow a Club within the South Eastern Women's League SEWF Division 1 or Division 2 or South East Development competitions to request a player from the Frankston District Junior Football League (FDJFL) playing in the 2018 FDJFL U18 Girls competition.

Player(s) and Clubs party to this interchange agreement must be acquainted with the conditions of this agreement as outlined below.

### Conditions of Interchange Agreement:

1. Each Agreement is agreed on by all Leagues on an annual basis.
2. Interchange permits will only be issued to FDJFL registered players who are in the FDJFL U18 Girls competition and have turned 16 as of 1 January.
3. A FDJFL player may play with only one nominated SEWF club.
4. A maximum of 5 players can interchange from one Youth Girls team in the FDJFL to SEWF.
5. A player may interchange no more than 8 times during the FDJFL season.
6. The official Interchange Agreement form must be completed prior to the player playing and must be retained by the SEWF club to which the player wishes to permit. The form must be signed by the player and their parent/guardian, and the FDJFL Club President or Secretary before entering the online Local Interchange permit (TYPE 2) request using the Sporting Pulse Footyweb IT system which must be finalised by 4pm on the Friday prior to the first permit game.
7. Each Permit is issued to the individual named for the date range specified. Incomplete interchange forms will be regarded as playing an unregistered player and penalties may apply.
8. A player cannot play more than one game per day. In the event that the juniors and seniors have matches scheduled on the same day, the player must play with their FDJFL team in the junior competition.
9. Player can be interchanged during finals series, provided that the player has met the SEWF finals' eligibility criteria, and that her FDJFL U18 Girls team is not playing finals on the same weekend (includes Fridays).
10. Any player selected to play FDJFL Interleague matches shall not be granted a permit for that weekend of matches.
11. Players who are reported for an on-field offence shall have the charge heard by the Independent Tribunal of the League within which the offence occurred and both Leagues shall apply the penalty.
12. A player cannot be interchanged whilst under suspension.
13. Any player or Club who is found to have breached this agreement may be subject to penalties as prescribed in the SEWF, and FDJFL By-Laws.
14. This agreement cannot be altered unless agreed to by SEWF managed by AFLSE and FDJFL.
